Stewardship Reflections—Transfigured & Transformed

Perhaps we may find it odd that the Apostles did not always seem to be aware of exactly who Jesus was. In fact, it took some time for most of them to recognize that Jesus was more than just an inspired rabbi. In time, Peter would be the first to profess that Jesus was the Christ, the Living Son of God made man. And yet, he still didn't always *get* it. In today's Gospel, after Peter sees Jesus transfigured and conversing with Moses and Elijah, his initial reaction is that they should put up three tents, symbolic of his temporal nature in this temporal world. This suggestion seems to be at odds with Peter's own profession just a few days earlier that Jesus is the Christ. It would not be the last time that Peter would stumble in his recognition of the Divinity of Jesus, and yet, Jesus would entrust him with the keys to the Church! Let us also remember all we have been entrusted with! Our Lord trusts us, like Peter, to be stewards of His church and one another. He wishes to use our discipleship to transform us from the ordinary to the extraordinary, from the temporal to the eternal.

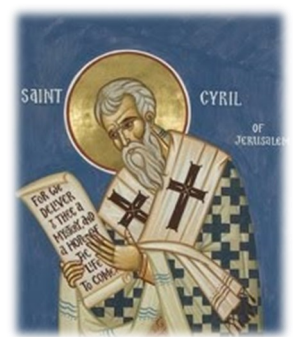
Saint Cyril of Jerusalem

*Died c.315-c.386 | Feast Day: March 18th
 Patron: Catechists*

Reflection: The political upheaval and theological struggles that Cyril dealt with were a little different from what we experience today. Conciliatory by nature, Cyril suffered immensely from the factionalism of his day that often ended in bitter recriminations. In disputes he was accused by both parties as being too sympathetic to the other side. And today Cyril is a saint and Doctor of the Church. When arguments about "right" belief lead to faction, labeling, and a culture of communications that doesn't reverence all parties in the discussion, Cyril's example suggests that we take a step back and seek to understand and work together. How do I respond to conflict, especially when it comes to issues of faith?

Prayer: Saint Cyril of Jerusalem, may I serve the Church as you did, in a way that is upright, just, and fair. Amen
