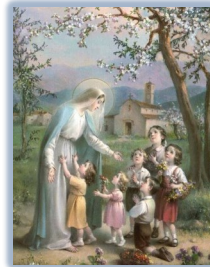
ANNUAL MAY MARIAN COLORING CONTEST

A year of the Eucharist event

Come learn about 15 year old Blessed Carlo Acutis (1991- 2006), the modern day teen who dedicated his life to Jesus and traveled around the globe to catalogue the Eucharistic Miracles. Carlo completed this work in 2005 and died a year later of leukemia at the young age of 15. He was beatified "Blessed" by Pope Francis October 10, 2020, after being credited with curing a Brazilian boy from a rare pancreatic defect that made eating difficult.



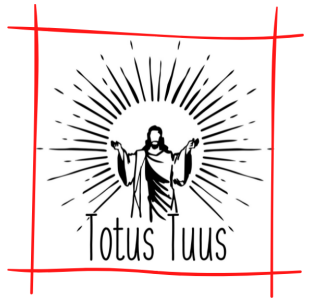
