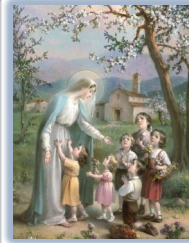
### SILENT AUCTION

### CEMETERY RULES & MOWING SCHEDULE 2022

Items not permanently attached to the grave monument or the bases (see diagram) will be removed and disposed of during the period of time from two weeks following Memorial Day to two weeks prior to All Souls’ Day. This rule is in effect because of the weekly mowing and trimming. It is too difficult for the volunteers who care for the cemetery to remove and replace items during weekly maintenance. This rule does include “shepherd’s hooks” and “solar lights” that people incorrectly place in the ground around the pad of the headstone. If you wish to have a shepherd’s hook or solar light at the grave, they must be properly placed in the concrete pad that supports the headstone and headstone base and you need to call the Parish Office (316-796-1224) to arrange to have it attached properly.

Items that qualify as “permanently attached to the headstones” include vases and the flowers contained within them and statues. These items, however, must be incorporated as part of the headstone or the base itself (this would be specified to the monument company at the time you order the headstone), or permanently affixed to the headstone or base (not the concrete pad). All permanently attached items should not protrude out over the ground area surrounding the grave because this also creates problems with access for maintenance and the items may become damaged.

In summary, anything that actually blocks the mowing and trimming of the volunteers who must trim around each and every grave and headstone, will have to be removed. Thank you, and God bless you for your cooperation. Feel free to call the parish office if you have additional questions (316-796-1224).

## HOLY FAMILY CAMP 2022

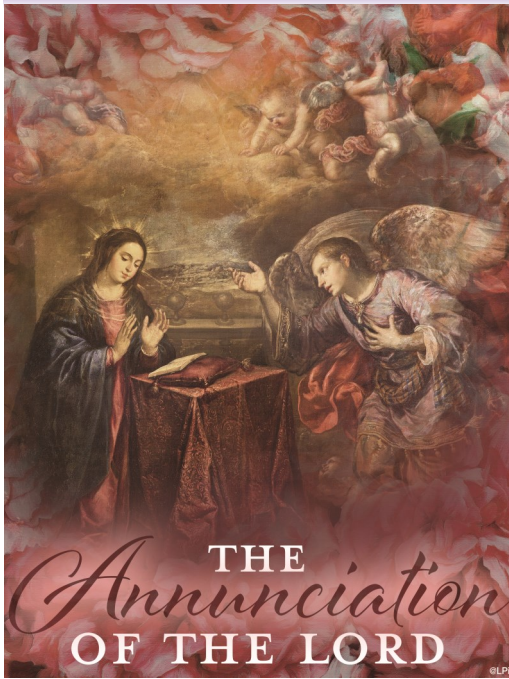
June 5-9, 2022

### Stewardship Reflection: Fruitless Trees

*Ex 3:1-8A, 13-15 / 1 Cor 10:1-6, 10-12 / Lk 13:1-9*

A seemingly minor player in today's Gospel is the fig tree that does not bear fruit. The owner of the orchard wants to cut it down because it is exhausting the soil. The gardener, however, asks for the opportunity to give the tree special attention, to cultivate the ground around it and fertilize it. This, brothers and sisters, is discipleship! We are surrounded by fruitless fig trees...some of us may even BE the fruitless tree! Discipleship does not mean we stand and stare and complain about a tree's lack of fruit. It doesn't mean grumbling about the way it is exhausting the soil. Discipleship means helping that fig tree thrive by caring for it. Like the gardener, we have to get our hands dirty as we nurture the tree and help it bear fruit. This means praying for and with one another, going to Mass together, and discovering the unique "fruits" God has placed within each of us. Just as the fig tree cannot fertilize itself, neither can we alone sustain ourselves. Discipleship means recognizing others as gift and supporting one another.

### Saint Óscar Romero

*August 15, 1917 - March 24, 1980 | Feast Day: March 24th*

*Patron: Christian communicators, persecuted Christians, El Salvador, the Americas*

Reflection: Óscar never wanted to be a political figure. He was a man of prayer who had deeply developed his interior life based on the spirituality of Opus Dei, as recorded in his diary. As a bishop, he felt a greater responsibility to take action. This was not at odds with his prayer life, but flowed from his commitment to Jesus Christ. How can I strengthen my commitment to Jesus?

Prayer: Saint Óscar Romero, you showed us that our commitment to Christ leads us to make a gift of ourselves to those in need. Pray for us that we might generously respond to the needs of the people of our day and lead them to the light of Christ. Amen
