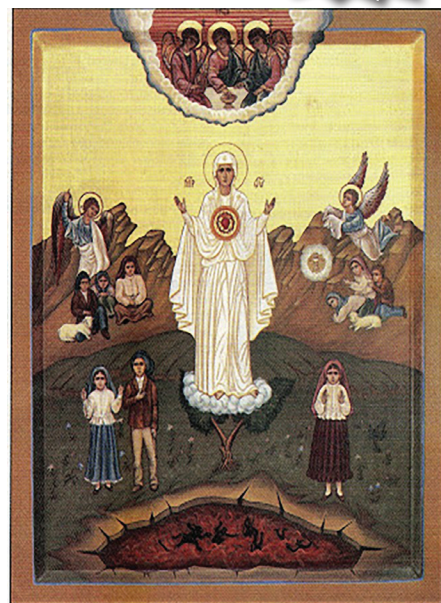

In 1917, Our Lady appeared to three shepherd children and entrusted to them Heaven's peace plan. The Blessed Virgin Mary promised that the whole world would be in peace, and that many souls would be saved if her requests were heeded. She told us that war is a punishment for sin; that God would punish the world for its sins by means of conflicts, hunger, persecution of the Church and persecution of the Pope, unless we obeyed the commandments of God.

To celebrate the Centenary of the Fatima apparitions and to revisit Our Lady's important message, **everyone**—priests, religious and laity—is invited to attend this special weekend intended for spiritual renewal, reflection and affirmation of the role of the consecrated life in the call to prayer, conversion and consecration.

## Special Friday Morning Session for Religious, Priests & Consecrated Persons

Before the National Meeting, **Msgr. Charles Mangan** and Franciscan **Sr. Alicia Torres**, will speak at the Friday morning session at Marytown, exclusively for priests, religious and other consecrated persons. Their reflections will specifically focus upon those who embrace the evangelical counsels, and show that Our Lady's message at Fatima can greatly assist them to live their lives in closer union with Christ as "Living Signs of the Gospel."

## Scheduled Speakers:



**Most Rev. Robert Vasa** is the President of the INSTITUTE ON RELIGIOUS LIFE. Originally from the Diocese of Lincoln, he was ordained to the priesthood in 1976. In 1999 he was appointed Bishop of Baker by Pope St. John Paul II. He was later appointed Coadjutor Bishop and later Ordinary of the Diocese of Santa Rosa in 2011.



**Rev. Andrew Apostoli, C.F.R.**, a founding member of the Franciscan Friars of the Renewal, has been teaching and preaching retreats and parish missions for several decades. He is considered an expert on the apparitions at Fatima, is the author of numerous books, and has hosted a number of EWTN television series including *Fatima for Today*.



**Rev. Brian Mullady, O.P.**, is a nationally-known Dominican priest, retreat master and spiritual director, and EWTN television host. Besides giving parish missions, Father teaches at Holy Apostles Seminary and the *Vita Consecrata* Institute. He also writes for a number of Catholic publications and is the author of many theological books.



**Msgr. Charles Mangan** is a priest of the Diocese of Sioux Falls. Having worked in the Congregation for Institutes of Consecrated Life & Societies of Apostolic Life in Rome, Monsignor now directs the Office of the Marian Apostolate, as well as serving as Vicar for Consecrated Life and as a canonical advisor for his bishop.



**Sr. Alicia Torres, F.E.**, is a member of the Franciscans of the Eucharist of Chicago. Sister earned a M.Div. degree from the University of St. Mary of the Lake—Mundelein Seminary in 2015, and now serves Our Lord through her religious consecration, Eucharistic adoration, service to the poor, evangelization and teaching.



**Outdoor Procession & Public Rosary.** To commemorate the Centenary of Our Lady of Fatima's apparitions, we will have an outdoor procession with the Pilgrim Virgin Statue, along with the public recitation of the Holy Rosary following Friday's opening Mass (weather permitting).



**Deacon Robert Ellis** is the National Coordinator for the World Apostolate of Fatima, based in Washington, New Jersey. Deacon Ellis was ordained to the permanent diaconate in 1986, and has served as the spiritual director of the Green Bay, Wisconsin, division of the World Apostolate of Fatima for over ten years.



**Rev. Dwight Campbell** was ordained a priest in 1991, and is the pastor of Our Lady of Mt. Carmel Parish in Kenosha, Wisconsin. Before becoming a priest he earned a Juris Doctor degree and practiced law. In 2009, Father completed a Doctorate in Sacred Theology in Mariology from the Marian Research Institute, Dayton, Ohio.



**Rev. Matthew Hincks, ORC**, is a member of the Canons of the Holy Cross, based in Carrollton, Ohio. The Canons oversee the *Opus Sanctorum Angelorum*, an international movement approved by the Holy See, which promotes devotion to the Holy Angels, so that these spiritual beings may lead us more effectively to God.



**Thomas Dunn** is the president of the Chicago Blue Army—World Apostolate of Fatima, and serves as the Vicariate VI Coordinator of the Saint John Paul II Eucharistic Adoration Association. He also coordinates the visits of the Fatima Pilgrim Virgin statues that bring many graces throughout the Archdiocese of Chicago.



**Susan Tassone** has long been a passionate champion for the Holy Souls in purgatory and is recognized as leading the "purgatory movement" in the United States. A best-selling author, popular speaker and frequent guest on radio and TV shows, she holds a master's degree in religious education from Loyola University.



**Sr. John Marie Zwenger, IHM**, is a member of the Sisters of the Immaculate Heart of Mary of Wichita. Her community practices and promotes the Five First Saturdays devotion for the conversion of sinners and in reparation to Our Lady's Immaculate Heart. Sister currently is working on a Master's degree in Systematic Theology.
